Something that breaks down naturally, without damaging the environment.

Biodiversity

The variety of all living things on Earth.

Renewable

Used to describe a resource that can be used repeatedly and replaced naturally, like solar power.

Conservation

The act of keeping something safe from destruction, loss or waste.

Pollution

The contamination of the environment. This is usually through waste, chemicals and greenhouse gases.

Circular economy

The endless process of designing, using, reusing and recycling goods to minimise waste.

Reusable

An item that can be used more than once. This reduces waste and conserves resources.
