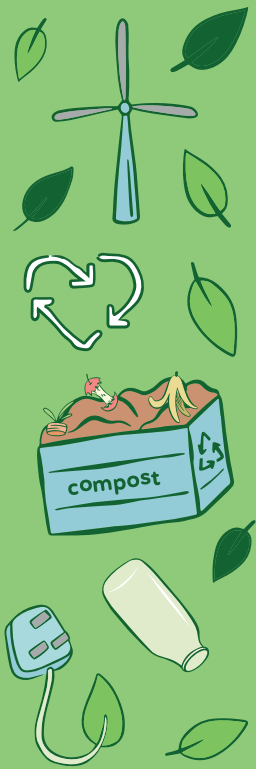

DEFINITION

Maintaining the resources and world we live in for future generations.

The variety of all living things on Earth.

Collecting materials you're about to throw out so they can be reused.

The endless process of designing, using, reusing and recycling goods to minimise waste.

A community of organisms interacting with each other and the environment.
