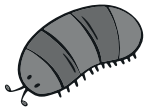


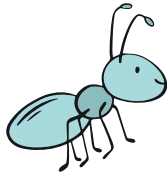
# COMPOSTING CRITTERS

Here are some of the creepy crawlies you can find in your compost! Match the critter to its role in composting.



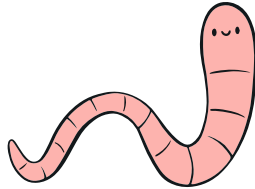
**Pill bug**

You'll find me creating passageways in the compost heap while scavenging for food.



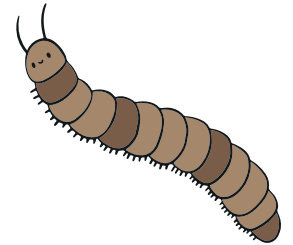
**Worm**

Circle which items you can put into your compost. Bonus round – use a green marker to circle the green materials and use a brown marker to circle the brown materials.



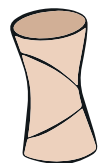
