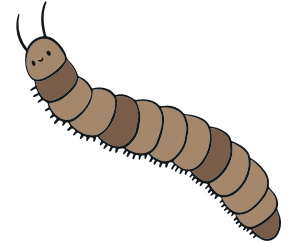
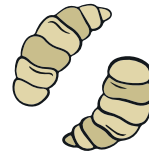
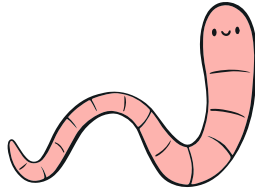
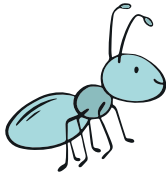
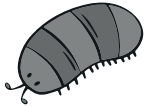


COMPOSTING CRITTERS

I love to eat sticks, branches and kitchen scraps. When I'm frightened, I roll up into a ball.

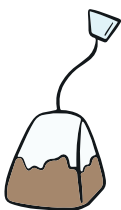
Don't be alarmed with all my legs, I promise I'm quite harmless! I love to eat dead plants, sticks, branches, and leaves.
